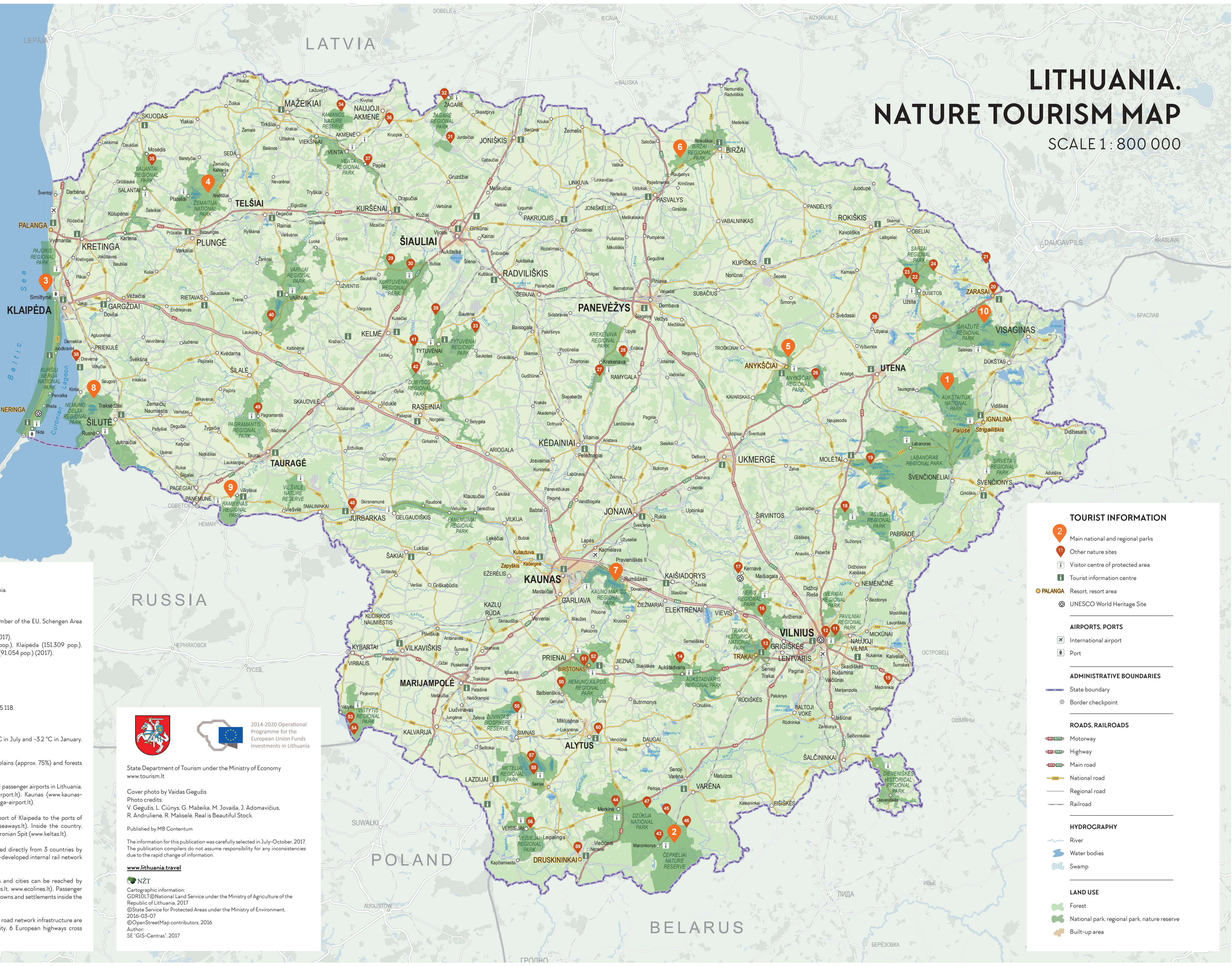

Rivers and lakes of pure spring waters, forests of countless shades of green, meadows bustling with life, virtually impassable marshes, magnificent sand dunes and mysterious sinkholes are just some of the miracles granted to Lithuania and its visitors by Mother Nature. The natural assets formed over thousands of years and largely unaffected by human activity are probably the most significant and cherished treasure of Lithuania.

We have selected ten national and regional parks of differing landscapes where you can go to experience the diversity and uniqueness of Lithuanian nature. We offer active recreation: therefore we have prepared routes in every direction that should be taken on foot, by bicycle or by canoe depending on the peculiarities of the location. Become one with nature – inhale deeply and feel the freshness of the waters and the fragrance of the herbs of Lithuania.

For those wishing to know what awaits them along a specific path, we have developed augmented reality solutions, i.e. videos that you can watch on your mobile device. All you have to do is download the OVERLY application from the App Store or Google Play, open the app and scan a photo you are interested in.

Do not hesitate to feel, smell, hear and know the nature of Lithuania!

5 ANYKŠČIAI REGIONAL PARK

The clean pine forest air and a diverse landscape rich in river valleys, lakes, forests, fauna and flora as well as meticulously developed tourism and recreation infrastructures attract a lot of visitors to Anykščiai Regional Park. If you wish to get a closer look at the nature of the park, you should definitely walk along the 4.7km nature trail through the famous Anykščiai Pinewood situated along the Šventoji River. The trail starts at the end of Vilnius Street, is marked with green circles painted on the trees and features 20 educational stops along the way. As soon as you start your journey, pay close attention to the **Pine Tree with Hollows** containing more than 20 holes. When you turn west, the **Slav Exposure** with formations of three geological systems opens up in front of your eyes. At the end of the trail you will find the second largest stone in Lithuania, **Puntukas**, and one of the most popular tourist attractions of Lithuania – the **Treetop Walking Path**, a unique construction that allows visitors to stroll along the treetops at a height of 21m. A 34m tower offers a panoramic view of the surrounding area.



1 AUKŠTAITIJA NATIONAL PARK

The landscape of this region reveals its full beauty to visitors – stream-connected lakes offering great water tourism opportunities and high hills serving as observation towers of the surroundings. A large part of the park is located in the resort district of Ignalina.

The most popular water trail runs along the lakes of Aukštaitija. The Great Circle is around 25km (from Palūšė to Linkmenas Lake) and can be easily covered in one or two days. The journey starts at Lūšiai Lake to Dringys Lake and then to Dringys Lake. At the end of Dringys Lake canoes are transported to Baluošas Lake (1.5km). Make sure to stop by Ginučiai not only to carry your canoes across the road but also to visit **Ginučiai Water Mill** with its authentic 19th-century equipment. The camping sites by Almajas Lake are perfect spots to stay overnight. On the next day, enjoy the views along the Almaja River, Asekas Lake and, finally, Linkmenas Lake. On the shore of Linkmenas Lake there is the hill of **Ladakalnis** offering a picturesque vista of six lakes and next to it – **Ginučiai Hillfort**, the finish point of the journey, where the Linkmenas Castle stood in the 12th–15th centuries.

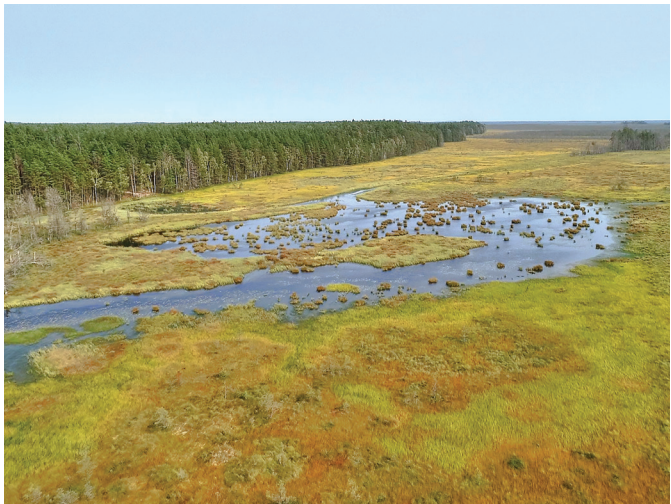


6 BIRŽAI REGIONAL PARK

Biržai is a place that can look completely different every time you visit! Even today, the surface of the land in the region is actively forming due to karst processes – the groundwater dissolves the layers of gypsum, which causes the earth to open up and mysterious sinkholes or lakes take shape. Begin your journey from **Kirkilai Landscape Reserve** to the north of Biržai, which is famous for its small lakes formed from collapsed sinkholes. The area boasts at least 200 such lakes in 1km²! A nature trail 8km outside of Biržai is a great place to explore these lakelets up close or take in the beauty of the entire location from specially constructed **Kirkilai Observation Tower** (more than 30m high). If you are truly lucky, under certain circumstances, the lakelets can become coloured in different shades! The Village of Mantagailiškis, which is situated only 5km to the south of Kirkilai, offers a short (700m) **Geological Nature Trail** called **Badger Burrow**. The trail presents various sinkholes (The Hole of Geologists, Fox Burrow, Badger Burrow, etc.) from the outside and the inside.

2 DŽŪKIJA NATIONAL PARK AND ČEPKELIAI STATE STRICT NATURE RESERVE

The largest national park in Lithuania covering a territory of almost 60,000ha is dominated by pines representing a unique and rich world of nature. The park offers numerous nature trails suitable for hiking as well as family picnics; however, the greatest variety of routes are intended for cyclists. A 39km long cycling loop starts in Marcinkonys, 4.5km away along a forest track there is the 1.5km **Čepkeliai Marsh Nature Trail** (the trail can only be visited with an authorised employee or licensed nature guide from April 1 to July 1). Take a look at one of the most protected national assets from the observation tower and a walkway installed next to the raised bogs. Continue for nearly 10km along the bogs toward the **Bee Hollow Scenic Nature Trail**. At the end of the trail, five more kilometres away, you will find the Village of Musteika and its Wild Beekeeping Exposition introducing one of the oldest crafts of the Grand Duchy of Lithuania. The Village of Margionys and the **Old Woman's Garden Spring**, one of the fountain springs of the Skroblius Stream, are situated 8km from Musteika. The final 11km stretch back to Marcinkonys is on smooth asphalt road.



7 KAUNAS LAGOON REGIONAL PARK

The Kaunas Lagoon is the largest artificial body of water in Lithuania. It was formed nearly six decades ago, when after the construction of the Kaunas Hydroelectric Power Station, the waters of the Nemunas River flooded a substantial part of the valley, covering an area of over 6,000ha. It goes without saying that the lagoon and its coastline are best admired from the water or somewhere nearby. During the warm seasons of the year, the jetty located near **Pažaislis Convent**, one of the most exquisite examples of Baroque architecture in Lithuania, offers 4.5h excursions of the Kaunas Lagoon with 1h stop at the **Juniper Valley** along **Arlaviškiai Nature Trail**. This is one of the most popular walking trails in Lithuania – the 1.3km loop offers not only splendid views of the lagoon but also the heavenly scent of junipers, the plant known for having the greatest healing powers in Lithuania. Should you need more exercise, visit the 1.6km **Žiegdžiai Geological Trail** located approximately 13km from the jetty. The trail runs along the steep coasts of the lagoon; **Kalniškiai Conglomerate Exposure** is its greatest treasure. It is the only place in Lithuania where you can actually see stalactite formations.



3 KURŠIŲ NERIJA NATIONAL PARK AND SEASIDE REGIONAL PARK

Travellers agree that the best way to see Lithuanian Baltic seaside is by bicycle – there is a seaside cycling route running from the Latvian border and through Lithuanian resorts Palanga and Neringa. Stop by in Karklė, not far away from Klaipėda, to admire the steepest seashore in Lithuania – the **Dutchman's Cap Cliff** (24m). In the vicinity, you will also find the ancient **Littorina Sea Coast**, formed by the waves and lined with springs, the uniqueness of which can be best witnessed from a 3km nature trail. Take a ferry from Klaipėda to Smiltynė and you will get to the Curonian Spit, which is listed among UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Juodkrantė, the first settlement, is only 25km from the ferry terminal. The must-visit sites include the original 3m high and 3m wide **Sound Catcher**, the dwelling place of witches and devils, the **Hill of Witches**, and the **colony of grey herons and great cormorants**. Make sure to stop and admire the magnificent dunes from the viewing points at approximately every 10km along the way. The 11km Nagliai Nature Trail reveals the beauty of the **Dead Dunes**. Preila is home to **Vecėkrugas Dune** (Old Inn Dune), and Nida is known for its **Paraidis Dune**.



8 NEMUNAS DELTA REGIONAL PARK

The landscape of the seaside region is dominated by water – rivers, canals, lakes, seaside bogs and moors. Naturally, the impressions are the greatest if you come in the spring during the floods when the delta meadows are under water and are full of migrating birds. Start from the Visitor Centre of Nemunas Delta Regional Park in Rusnė. **Rusnė Island** as well as the seaside cultural heritage can be best explored along the educational trail **Surrounded by Flood Waters** (advance registration only). If you prefer walking and bird watching, try out **Tulkiaragė Nature Trail** (1.2km) that runs along a mound and tells the story of the everyday life of man and water, or **Aukštumala Nature Trail** (1.2km), a wooden walkway that twists and winds along the route of a former underwater stone path in the raised bogs. Continue your journey to the Ventė Cape peninsula. Every year **Ventė Cape Ornithological Station**, in operation since 1929, rings several thousand of birds. Make sure to visit **Ventė Cape Lighthouse** right next door, one of the few lighthouses in Lithuania that you can enter and take a look around.

4 ŽEMAITIJA NATIONAL PARK

Most of the tourist sites of this national park are located around Plateliai Lake and the nearby town of the same name, rich with history. Choose a 24km cycling loop around the lake to discover the treasures of this mysterious location in Lithuania. Start in Plateliai and cycle south toward Beržoras Village. On your way, visit the 15m **Siberia Observation Tower**. The route continues along the lake bays called *Laumalenkos*. When you pass the mouth of the Babrungas River and Plokštinė Nature Reserve, visit the **Cold War Exposition**, which is the only exposition of its kind in Europe displayed in an underground Soviet missile launch facility. If you wish to explore the surroundings in more detail, take a walk along the 3km **Plokštinė** or 2.3km **Paplatelė Nature Trails**. If you continue your journey along the lake shore, make sure to visit the **Bird Observation Post** near the pond of Pakastuva (between the Villages of Paežers-Rūdičiai and Medsedžiai) and the 16m deep **Piktežeris Lake** along **Šeirė Nature Trail** that turns into a dangerous moor. Finish your journey at **Plateliai Lake Viewing Platform** where you can take in a magnificent vista of Pliis, Versiai and Pliksalė Islands as well as the old Plateliai – the Sventorkalnis Peninsula.



9 RAMBYNAS REGIONAL PARK

This small park is simply fascinating not only because of magnificent Rambynas Hill and the picturesque vista of the lower reaches of the Nemunas River it offers but also the surviving spirit of Lithuania Minor. Begin your hike from **Rambynas Hill** located near the Nemunas River and the Lithuania-Kaliningrad Oblast border. The hill was once the sacred site of the Scalovians (a Baltic tribe). Enjoy the views of the towers of Ragaine Castle and the town of Tilsit from a modern-day viewing platform. Follow the nature trail down Rambynas Hill and continue for approximately 2km until you reach the Village of Bitenai, which is famous for its **white stork colony** in the pine forest right in the middle of the village. Across from the village you will find a true Mecca of book smugglers – the farmstead of Martynas Januskas, the prominent intellectual of Lithuania Minor, which now houses the museum and open-air gallery **Lithuania Minor Picture Garden**. Continue south for 1km from the centre of Vilkyskiai and you will find a parking lot. Follow the forest path leading from the parking lot for approx. 1.4km to see the **Fire Tree of Witches** with 17 trunks (Vilkyskiai Forest).



10 GRAŽUTĖ AND SARTAI REGIONAL PARKS

The lake-rich resort territory of Zarasai located along the Latvia-Belarus border encourages nature enthusiasts to visit Gražutė and Sartai Regional Parks. Gražutė Regional Park has more than 100km of cycling trails! **The Great Cycling Loop** in Gražutė is 45km long and connects the most fascinating sites of the park – crystal clear **Sventas Lake**, the **Antalietė Lagoon**, the highest stone temple in Lithuania, **Salakas Church of Our Lady of Sorrows** and more. Should you wish to explore the surroundings of Salakas more carefully, take the 5km **Salakas Nature Trail**. If you enjoy hiking, Gražutė Regional Park offers a lot of interesting trails. Just walk along the 1.5km **Savaša Nature Trail** and you will feel as if you are hiking in the mountains – every kilometre the waters of the Savaša River fall from a dizzying height of 11m. When you visit Degučiai, do reserve some time for **Degučiai Nature Trail** (2km) and let yourself be overwhelmed by the scents of a century-old pine forest. Sartai Lake, which is famous throughout Lithuania, is a true treasure of Sartai Regional Park. Right next to it there is the town of Dusetos, a favourite of artists. Do not forget to visit **Dusetos Sculpture Park** and the exposition at the Visitor Centre of Dusetos Regional Park.
