












Geographical position:



Birute Park is the Pearl of Palanga. It Becomes More Beautiful Every Year

Comfortable relax in Palanga cannot be imagined not only without the sea but also without a walk in Birute Park, one of the most beautiful parks in Northern Europe. This resort area is called the pearl of Palanga and is adorned every year in order to make it even more attractive to holidaymakers.

Birute Park was established in the territory of the former sacred Birute Forest and Birute Hill. At the end of XIX century, famous French architect Édouard François André at the order of Tiškevičiai prepared a project for a landscape park.

Brilliantly designed park has a large variety of images and sentiments with skilfully arranged pathways and flowerbeds in the yards. This swampy area of Tiškevičiai estate was overgrown with hassocks. At the request of the counts, ponds were excavated in this place and the soil was used for the construction of the palace. The famous Amber Museum is now located in the neo-renaissance style mansion built on this estate in 1897.

Traditionally, brass music fans gather in park rotunda three times a week on every summer Thursday, Friday and Saturday at 6:30 p.m. where professional orchestra of Palanga in the surroundings of nature gives free concerts for the residents and guests of Palanga. The series of chamber music concerts "Night Serenades" (It. "Nakties serenados") is just another traditional event that has been celebrating in Palanga, Birute Park and Amber Museum for more than a decade.

Tiškevičiai Palace is Palanga decoration with spread wings

Representative Tiškevičiai palace in Palanga was built in the holy (according to the local people) place, in Palanga Birutė forest, near the Baltic Sea in 1897. The palace is surrounded by Palanga Botanical Park, which was started to form during the construction of the palace at the end of 19th century.

Great French landscape architect Édouard François André (1840-1911) is the author of the park project. German architect from Berlin Franz Heinrich Schwechten (1841-1924) is the author of the building project. This two-story brick building was built on for permanent life of Count Feliksas Tiškevičius (1870-1932) in Palanga.


This is a neo-classical palace with renaissance, baroque, classicism features and composition elements. The building has a regular configuration, a curved facade with a semicircular terrace. The front stairs adorned with lion sculpture and vases made in Paris. There is a columns portico and a balcony with a balustradeon on the south side of the palace facade. From this side you get to the rosary. The octagonal chapel with a neo-renaissance style features a dome-shaped roof in front of the western facade of the palace. The facades of the palace are of two slots, windows and portals are decorated with elements.

The Count Feliksas Tiškevičius decorated the palace. Tiškevičiai proposed to the Lithuanian Government to buy a park with a palace in 1939. It was planned to install the representative summer residence of the President of the Republic of Lithuania.

During the war and postwar years the building was badly damaged. The palace was restored in 1957 according to the project of architect Alfredas Brusokas. After that, for several years there was the Lithuanian Artists' Union's Creative House. Artists in this House not only created, organized exhibitions of their works, but also rested.

According to the order of the Ministry of Culture of the Republic of Lithuania, the branch of the Lithuanian Art Museum - Amber Museum - has been opened in Tiškevičiai Palace on August 3, 1963, which has been functioning here till now.

Birute Hill Whispers Legends of the Past

When walking in Birute Park, one of the most beautiful places in Palanga, be certain to visit Birute Hill. The centuries-old sacred Birute pine forest still thrives in the territory of former Tiškevičiai Palace. It surrounds the legendary Birute Hill standing 21 meters above the sea level and opens the magnificent view of soughing sea.

You will not only have a good time in the nature but also be able to travel to ancient times – the fact that people lived here a long time ago is proven by discoveries of ceramics on the hill dating back to the first millennium. Settlement complex of Curonians usually consisted of a castle, one or more settlements and an oblation table. A Palace and oblation table on the Birute Hill date back to 9 – 13 centuries, a village was established at the foot of the hill. A defensive wall was built on the hill at the end of 14 century – the beginning of 15 century which was probably burnt during the fights with Crusaders.

Later, a pagan sanctuary with paleoastronomy observatory was set up here. This sanctuary is linked with the name of the priestess Birute, the wife of Duke Kestutis and the mother of Vytautas. Stories tell that she lived here and kept the holy fire burning and was buried here after her death.

A neo-gothic chapel designed by architect K. Mayer was built on the top of Birute Hill In 1898. In 1976 the chapel was decorated with stained-glass created by the artist L. Pocius.

Sculpture "For You, Birute"

This sculpture was built at the foot of Birute Hill in 1965. The author is K. Petrikaitė-Tulienė. The sculpture marks the symbolic place of Birutė eternal rest, it is built on a stone bearing the inscription "For You, Birute".

Lourdes

It is typical classical park element of the XIX century. The French master Bonhomme in 1898 was ordered by Count Tiškevičiai, under the Christian tradition to place a famous copy of Lourdes at the foot of the hill. Natural stones from the surrounding settlements were used for the construction of Lourdes. During the interwar period, when Vytautas Magnus (and therefore his mother, Duchess Birutė) cult grew up, the religious rituals, celebrations, events of national and Christian organizations were often held at Lourdes. In Soviet times, after the removal of St. Mary sculpture, poetry evenings were organized at Lourdes. Large St. Mary sculpture stood in Lourdes niche; currently a copy of original sculpture is placed there.

Park Sculptures

The park has 9 sculptures. "Egle the Queen of Serpents" is the most famous of them; it is one of the most beautiful and best-known works of sculptor R. Antinis (senior).

At the central entrance to the park there is a monument to the park's developer, landscape engineer from Édouard François André, and in the northern part of the park, along the S. Darius and S. Girénas street, you will see sculpture "Sagittarius" created by sculptor S. Šarapovas and architect A. Knyva.


In the central part of the park, at the beginning of the great parterre (in front of Tiškevičiai Palace) stands the sculpture "The Blessing Christ". It was brought to Palanga from Paris according to the order of Count F. Tiškevičius, but it was destroyed in 1948. It was restored by sculptor Stasys Žirgulis in 1993.

In rosary, beyond the Count Tiškevičiai Palace, a sculpture "Rebeka" ("Water Carrier") by French sculptor Hubert Luis-Noel was built in 1983.

In the southeast part of the park, a small parterre, decorated with flower beds, a fountain and sculptures was reconstructed. The sculptures of women of one and a half-meter high depicting the seasons are appointed on one meter high pedestal. Park's administrative building, greenhouses, and glasshouse are next to the small parterre.

Sea Pier is the Symbol of Palanga

It is impossible to imagine Palanga without the Sea Pier, a place attracting everyone. Beautiful scenery of dunes, yellow beaches and limitless sea open before the eyes of onlooker, the sounds of the sea and shrieks of seagulls fill in the air. Evenings may be comfortably spent on the benches watching the last amazing sunsets into the sea.

Palanga was ruled by Counts Tiškevičiai at the end of the 19th century. They decided to build a dock for ships that could be used to transport bricks made in counts' brickyard. The dock was built in 1884-1888 and the vessel "Phoenix" cruised to Klaipeda and Liepaja. Later, when the export of bricks failed, the ship was used for transportation of passengers. Unfortunately, after storms the dock would be covered in sand, therefore, it was realized that the bridge was not suitable for navigation.

Since 1892, the pier became the most popular place for taking walks. Impacts of time, sea waves and wind destroyed this structure, thus, a new pier of 470 meters length was built on concrete poles in 1998.

The sculpture "Jūratė and Kastytis" (sculptress N. Gaigalaitė) was built nearby square in 1961 and became another symbol of the resort.

Jono Basanavičiaus Street

This is the central city street. Previously, this street was called the Tiškevičius street or the boulevard. During the interwar Dr. Jonas Basanavičius visited Palanga. In honour of the patriarch of the nation, the citizens of Palanga named Tiškevičius Boulevard on behalf of J. Basanavičius.

Every visitor repeatedly passes through this street, because there are many cafes, various attractions, this is the main street leading towards the sea bridge.

Counts Tiškevičiai Avenue

The reconstructed Counts Tiškevičiai Avenue seems to be moving into the past - this public space is filled with the spirit of the beginning of 19th century - the end of the 20th century. The renovated avenue is the honour of Palanga citizen to the resort's founders Counts Tiškevičiai. Therefore, the avenue is decorated not by accident with two bronze sculptural compositions "Countess Antanina Sofija Loncka - Tiškevičienė" and "Counts Feliksas Tiškevičius". The composition of these two sculptures consists of one piece, which unites the part of the alley, entering into the territory of valuable Kurhaus building of Palanga. Sculptor Klaudijus Pūdymas and architect Snieguolė Stripinienė are the creators of this composition.

The sculptural compositions are combined with a decorative, stainless metal band on the floor, in which the motto of the Tiškevičiai family in the Latin and Lithuanian languages "Deligas quem diligas" and "Choose what you love" is engraved with a repeating rhythm. The Counts Tiškevičiai Avenue is also decorated with original retro style chandeliers, paving and small architecture.

The historic gate decorated with carvings at Kestučio Street is the other adornment of the Avenue. It symbolyses the fact that summer residents are met and invited to visit Kurhaus in Tiškevičiai resort. According to the materials of the ancient history of Palanga, the wooden gates decorated with carvings were built according to Richard Dorschfeldt's collection of illustrations "Holzbauten der Gegenwart" ("Present Wooden Buildings") issued in 1901 in Stuttgart".



Sculpture Park Fascinates with the Works of Acknowledged Artists

The sculpture park is located in the city centre at the crossing of Vytauto and J. Simpsono Streets. This park attracts not only the attention of passers-by, it is also the place of attraction for those preferring quiet relaxation with family, children or friends. Here you can play gigantic outdoor chess. Visitors at the Sculptures Park can enjoy sculptures handed over to the Palanga City Municipality by the Lithuanian Art Museum. The exposition includes valuable works by sculptors from Latvia, Estonia, Ukraine, and Armenia.

Dancing Musical Fountain

The musical fountain is astonishing free-livers during the warm season with music, light and water dance. An interesting melody, according to which the fountain will dance, can be selected for an additional fee by SMS from a special playlist. Every day enthusiasts are delighted with free hourly performances.

The impressive effect of light music is created by 260 installed water jets and 48 different color lights, which obtain marking of all colors. The fountain reaches a height of 8 meters and raises nearly 4.3 tons of water in a minute. According to the amount of water raised, the fountain installed in Palanga is the largest dancing fountain in Lithuania.

The Signatory Avenue is located in a historic location between the city church and the central post office, which is located on the site of the former Palanga progymnasium. Four of the future signatories of the February 16 Act: Antanas Smetona, Kazimieras Steponas Šaulys, Jurgis Šaulys and Steponas Kairys studied at this educational institution.

The authors of the Avenue with Stela are Professors of the Vilnius Academy of Arts and Laureates of the Lithuanian National Award Algirdas Žebrauskas and Arūnas Sakalauskas. Signatarų alėja

ŠVENTOJI

WHAT TO VISIT

Šventoji is a resort settlement on the Baltic coast, 12 km north of Palanga center. The settlement is located on the left bank of the Šventoji River, as it flows into the Baltic Sea. This is an ancient fishing village where archaeological findings date back to 3000 years B.C.

Over time, the fishermen's village has grown to the harbor, known since the 13th century. Šventoji harbor intensively operated in the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries, constituting serious competition to the ports of Klaipeda, Liepaja, Ventspils and Riga. The Swedish fleet destroyed the port in 1701, lumber it with stones and sand.

When Lithuania regained its independence, Šventoji as a part of the Curonia province belonged to Latvia. It was handed to Lithuania in 1921 by International Arbitration Commission headed by Lord J. Simpson's decision, since the majority of the population was Lithuanians.

Most of all, the Šventoji became famous and expanded after the Second World War. Šventoji was connected to Palanga in 1970 and became the part of Palanga resort. About 2 000 permanent residents live in Šventoji.



Sculpture Park "Stone Age"

The park is located in Šventoji, on the territory of the Health Center "Energetikas". Here since 2005 the international stone sculpture symposium is being organized annually and it attracts more and more professional sculptors from all over the world. There are currently 50 stone sculptures in the sculpture park.



Monkey Bridge

This is a shaky, hanging bridge over the Šventoji River, often called the Šventoji Sign. The bridge was built in 1973.




Šventoji Lighthouse

The red four-edged Šventoji Lighthouse from metal constructions was built at a distance of 780 m from the sea in 1957. Its height is 39 m. Lighthouse is a navigational signal with a signal reach of 31 km. During the entire period of operation, the Šventoji Lighthouse does not go out for more than an hour.

Sculpture "Fisherman's Daughters"

In the dunes, at the gate of Šventoji Harbor, an impressive 4-meter high sculptural composition "Fisherman's Daughters" was built in 1982. Zuzana Pranaityte is the author of the sculpture. These are three long-haired girls looking to the sea and waiting for the returning their father from fishing.





Palanga Resort Museum

Collections of archeology, history, ethnography, art, iconography, photography, video and sound recordings, and numismatics, faleristics, philately, writing and individual collections are formed in Palanga resort museum.

Villa Anapilis, where the resort museum is located, is one of the old buildings of the Lithuanian seaside resort architecture. It is also one of the first counts Tiškevičiai family villas that have survived to this day.

Villa Anapilis was named after the First World War, when it was sold to brothers Vailokaičiai. One legend told by Palanga residents tell about Sofija Tiškevičienė's interest in inviting the souls. According to them, the countess had set up a secret mirror room above the attic, where she called soulsand they cbecause of the mirrors could not escape and return back to their world. It is also said that Sofia and her servant souls could be seen in the villa. The local people went in a distance of the villa because of the sounds emitted by the wind organs propagating there. It is said that the Countess Sofija Tiškevičienė was weak in health, and as soon as she felt worse, she went to listen to the sounds of the wind organ, which helped her to calm there.

Amber Museum

Representative Palanga Tiškevičiai Palace was built in 1897. The author of the project is the German architect Franz Heinrich Schwechten who lived in Berlin (1841-1924). This is a neoclassical palace with renaissance, baroque, classicism features and composition elements.

The Amber Museum belonging to the Lithuanian Art Museum settled in the former Count Feliksas Tiškevičius Palace on August 3, 1963. The museum is located in the majestic palace at the heart of Birute Park; it is one of the most visited places in the country. The museum has one of the world's largest collections of amber inclusions and uniques.

The Amber Museum acquaints you with amber formation, trade roads, mining, processing.

The ground floor admires visitors with the renovated historic interiors of the palace, telling about the life of Counts Tiškevičiai in this palace. A unique amber exposition is presented on the second floor; it is supplemented with archaeological items, as well as renewed inclusion collection.

The museum organizes short-term exhibitions, scientific conferences, and various educational activities.

Antanas Mončys House Museum

Lithuanian artist, sculptor modernist A. Mončys was born in the Mončių village, Kretinga district. The storms of World War II flooded him to the West and he lived and created in France.

The first floor of the museum acts as an exhibition hall with a constantly changing exposition. Over 200 sculptures, drawings, graphic works, collages, whistles, masks are exhibited on the second floor of the museum. They were donated after the death of the artist to Lithuania.

Memorial Homestead of the First Resort Burgomaster Jonas Šliūpas

Famous Lithuanian public activist of the 20th century, doctor Jonas Šliūpas moved to live in Palanga in 1930. Thanks to J. Šliūpas Palanga was granted city rights in 1933 and he was elected the first Burgomaster of Palanga.

J. Šliūpas memorial exposition was opened in his homestead in July of 1989 and the fragments of the history and ethnography of the Palanga town are displayed here, and the era of "Aušra" and "Varpas" is presented there also.



Kurhaus is the Symbol of the Resort

Classical and chamber music concerts in Palanga Kurhaus sound perfectly. Both the performers and the audience unanimously agree that the acoustics in this Count Tiškevičiai reminding building are particularly good.

The beginning of the history of the resort Kurhaus symbol is associated with the Tiškevičiai dynasty. The Count J. Tiškevičius built a spacious restaurant at the corner of the current Vytautas and J. Basanavičius streets in about 1877 which soon expanded and the first resort hotel was established there. Kurhaus has become a popular place for gathering holidaymakers, as there was not only the restaurant, but also a reading room, billiards and hall for other games. In this building there were also dances, performances and concerts. This is how Kurhaus became the heart of the newly created resort.

Palanga symbol burned on August 25, 2002, its restoration was started on May 30, 2012. A part of the masonry Kurhaus was restored during the year, the authentic materials of the Kurhaus mold were restored, the oak parquet was laid and walls were decorated with wallpapers, such as were used in the times of Kurhaus and times of Tiškevičiai. The Grand Kurhaus Hall was decorated by the chandelier of the end of 18th century.

Today Kurhaus is also open to the public. Various events and concerts are held in hall for 200 listeners. The new address of Kurhaus is Count Tiškevičiai Avenue No 1.

The Church of Palanga attracts not only the congregation

Church of the Assumption of the Virgin Mary was built in Palanga more than a hundred years ago and attracs by the neo-Gothic beauty and magnanimity almost every passing sight. Once inside, it is also a great place to admire: an impressive chapel and three artistic altars decorated with bas-reliefs are made of marble from France. On the central altar there is a painting of the Mother of God already mentioned in the 17th century.

The first small wooden Catholic Church built in Queen Ona Jogailaite's worry in Palanga was built around 1540. The other church of cross form with the tower and the bell-tower was built at the initiative of the then Lithuanian rulers in 1590.

The wooden church was rebuilt in 1767 and stood for 140 years. A new neo-Gothic church was built near the old wooden building under the project of the Swedish architect Karl Eduard Strandman in 1897. The works were fully financed by Count Feliksas Tiškevičius.

On August 15, the great anniversary celebrations take place mentioning the Assumption of Holy Mary's into Heavens, and the next Sunday after the Assumption Palanga celebrates St. Rokas feast.

Church of the Palanga Evangelical Lutheran

Palanga Evangelical Lutheran Parish was founded at the beginning of 20th century. At that time it was a branch of Kretinga parish. Since 1910 the congregation attended the services at the House of apothecary Oskar Berting. Later, on the second floor of the house a spacious room was appointed where the congregation prayed for 18 years. The community consisted of Lithuanian, Latvian and German people; therefore the priests preached in three languages. The first parish house was appointed and sanctified on Jürates street in 1928. In 1938 they burned.

The parish was restored in 1993. City municipality allocated a plot at Saulétekis street for the construction of the new church in 2000 and in 2005 Bishop M. Sabutis consecrated the cornerstone of the church. Irena and Gintas Likšai are the authors of the project.

Church of the Iverskaya Icon of the Mother of God in Palanga

The Russian Orthodox parish was founded in Palanga in 1995. First it was located in one of the rooms in the Russian school. In 1999 Palanga city municipality allocated a 2263 m² land plot for construction of the church. The church complex was designed by a Penza architect Dmitry Borunov. Construction of the church was completed in 2001.

Morning and evening services, sacraments of confession and communion are held in the church, religious holidays are celebrated there. There is a library (about 3000 books), a newspaper «Iverskaya Candle» is published. The newspaper informs about services held in the church, holidays and news of the church

Church of the Most Holy Virgin Mary – Star of the Seas in Šventoji (wooden)

Prelate J. Galdikas in 1929, as an inspector and lecturer at the Telsiai Seminary, on the bank of the Sventoji River, built a wooden church on <u>his sister Monika Kaunienė ho</u>mestead.

The builder also made a plan for the church. The Church was given the name 'Stella Maris' -Mary. Star of the Sea. It is said that there was a great storm in the sea that year, it hit fishermen at the sea, some of them drowned, some survived. The remaining living fishermen, in order to thank Mary for salvation, transported the material to the church by the barge to Šventoji, prepared at the Klaipėda furniture workshop. The material from Sventoji was transported to the construction site and lined up here.

There are two local monuments of art in the Church: St. Kazimier's painting (late 19th century, oil, canvas, author unknown) and bell (brass) with the inscription "Mark Ulman, Königsberg, 1608". This bell is one of the oldest in our country, it is older than all the bells of Palanga church.

Church of the Most Holy Virgin Mary – Star of the Seas

Catholic parish in Šventoji was founded in 1939, the chaplain of the ship "President Smetona", priest A. Račkauskas was appointed as administrator of the parish. Temporary church for the parish was built by Prelate J. Galdikas at his own expense (in one kilometre from the port, near the River Šventoji). Construction of the new church was designed by architects R. Krištapavičius and G. Aperavičius and was started in 1991. The church was consecrated by Bishop J. Boruta in 2003.

Church of the Evangelilic Lutheran in Butinge

In 1520 a Catholic church was built in Elija (Šventoji). After 1540 Elija's priest became familiar with Lutherans, and the church had got much closer to Curonians residing in this area. During the flood in the autumn of 1637, the church was washed down with water. Construction of a new church began in 1638. The church was destroyed and in 1809 the church in Elija collapsed again.

Tsar Alexander I visited Curonian province In 1816. Rucava priest Baunbach who participated in the ceremonial welcome of the tsar handed in to him an application of Butinge, Elija and other neighbouring villages' residents asking to restore the church in Elija. Alexander satisfied the request of the residents and allocated 40 000 roubles for implementation of this project. In 1822 basement for the stone church was layed next to the Butinge estate.


